Spring	Bookshelf (Inspect)	Back then, I devoured any book I could get my hands on, re-reading them over and over again until I could afford another one.
Spring	Toy Chest (Inspect)	That used to be my toy chest. What greater treasures are there for a child than his toys?
Spring	Model Airplane (Inspect)	My old model plane! I glued it and painted it all by myself. I'd forgotten about that but I'm glad to have this memory of it. I used to imagine it taking me to faraway places.
Spring	Globe (Inspect)	I used to spin that globe so fast eventually we had to replace the axles on it. Always daydreaming of being anywhere but here
Spring	Typewriter (Inspect)	I had so much pent up creativity that I'd use any medium I could get my hands on to express it. I remember writing some cheesy series of stories about something

Fall	Dead Plant (Inspect)	I really did try to keep that thing alive. But at some point I had only had the energy to keep myself together, and just barely.
Fall	Rolled Up Rug (Inspect)	Hated looking at that for a long time. Couldn't get rid of it, but I couldn't bear to feel it under my feet. Back when I thought I could hide from my feelings, but now I know. They catch up to you.
Fall	Windows (Inspect)	Shortest Fall I can remember. Leaves barely had time to change color before they all blew away.
Fall	Dirty Dishes (Inspect)	Lost the taste for music or really anything I used to enjoy. The only thing I let myself love was my own self-pity. What a waste.
Fall	TV Set (Inspect)	Thought that thing would be a nice distraction, but once you switch it off you're just staring at your own sad reflection. Or maybe that's just me.
Fall	Moving Box (Inspect)	I thought getting out of here would help, but I couldn't do it. I couldn't let go of this place.
